Study covered


- Website Review = 12 organisations in detail

Membership Model options

- Single gender
- Gender inclusive
- Age graded
- Family of organisations with single gender clubs
- Family Membership not found in <u>any</u> social organisation
- Associate Membership







Issues Identified

- Equality Law Our Protected Characteristics
 - Gender = Male
 - Religion = Catholic
- Our Constitutional Documents
 - Constitution = gender neutral
 - Rules = Rule 1 = male exclusive + male pronouns
 - Regulations = male pronouns
- How to change 2/3rds majority
 - CC and GBNC are administrative bodies.
 - Governing Body is the Membership



The Challenges

- How to evolve and become more inclusive within the current exclusively male governance,
- How to engage with younger people who are seeking a gender inclusive social organisation,
- How to retain members who question the need for change
