

Models of Membership Constitutional Impasse

- Local variations not allowed to permit trials
- Interpretation of Constitutional Documents
- Change difficult to achieve



Limits on Local Variations

- National Councils may make variations by way of Bylaw
- Variations are limited to the Regulations or Handbook
- Bylaws must not override the Constitution or Rules



Interpretation

- Interpretation of Constitutional documents Central Council after consultation with National Councils
- Disputes as to interpretation to be referred to Central Council for determination
- Theoretical appeal to the Courts



Change difficult to achieve

- Ordinary procedure
 - Successive approvals by Administrative bodies up to Central Council
 - Vote of members
- Extraordinary procedure
 - Motion to National Conference -200 members
 - Vote of members
- Both require 2/3rds majority of members voting
